

David and Mary (Sarratt) Brecheen are thought to be the parents of Elizabeth (Brecheen) Winn. The following sources provide the evidence:

Marriage Record, Person Co., NC - David Brechen married Marey Sarrett, 3 Sep. 1794 (According to the 1850 TN census, Elizabeth Brecheen Winn was born ca. 1803 in NC.)

U. S. Census, 1800, Person Co., NC - David Breecheen

Early TN Tax Lists - David Burcham, Maury Co., TN, 1811 and 1816

Deed Index, Maury Co., TN - David Bracken, 1836 (Zadoc Winn purchased land in this county in 1831 and 1833.)

U. S. Census, 1840, Marshall Co., TN, p. 192 - David C. Brecheen, age 60-70 (Zadoch Wynne also listed in Marshall Co. in 1840.)

Tax Record, Marshall Co., TN - David C. Brecham, 1840 (Zadoc Winn also on this tax list.)

Probate Deeds, Marshall Co., TN - David C. Brecheen to Edward A. Morris to indenture and bargain and sale of 100 acres of land in Marshall Co.....16 April 1840

Deed Record, Marshall Co., KY, 1841 - David C. Berkeen purchased land from Richard Nuckolls

Family Record Compiled by Jody Lassiter, a descendant - David C. Brecheen/Burkeen died ca. 1843, Calloway Co., KY; son Jesse W. Brecheen/Burkeen married Susannah Bridges (A bond for this marriage was recorded at the same time a bond was recorded for Zadok Winn and Elizabeth Brecheen. Jesse and Elizabeth are believed to be siblings.)

Deed Book 6, Conveyance to heirs, Marshall Co., KY, 1860 - David C. Berkeen/Burkeen, deceased; Jesse Berkeen named as heir (For some reason, Elizabeth Winn was not listed as an heir. Perhaps David's family had lost touch with her when she and Zadok moved from TN to AR.)

Based on the common places of residence in TN, the Maury Co., TN marriages of Elizabeth and Jesse, and the deed of conveyance to Jesse Berkeen, David Brecheen/Burkeen is thought to be the father of Elizabeth.
