P. 81 "ORDERED BY THE COURT THAT WILLIAM STONE WILLIAM M. ORR RICHARD WILKS ZADOC WINN MILTON B HOLY & TOLBER ARTHURS BE APPOINTED A JURY OF REVIEW TO LAY OFF AND MARK A ROAD COMMENCING AT WILLIAM STONES TERMINATING AT MOORESVILLE TAKING INTO CONSIDERATION THE GOOD OF THE PUBLIC AND THAT OF INDIVIDUALS AND REPORT TO THE NEXT TERM OF THIS COURT. ISSUED."

WILLIAM STONES FROM THENCE TO MOORESVILLE TOLBERT ARTHUR, ZADOC WINN, RICHARD HILLS HANDS, WILLIAM PINK, DOMSEY POWELL, NATHAN POWELL, F.F. DYER & WILLIAM SPACK. ISSUED."
